

FMC Technologies, Inc. Graduate Fellowship

FMC Technologies, Inc. provides a \$9,000 stipend in the second year of the MBA, and the Illinois MBA waives the second year tuition for selected candidate(s). MBA candidates apply after their first semester of their MBA; must be recommended by the MBA program; and then are reviewed by the *Committee of Three*, comprised of representatives from FMC Technologies, Inc., the University of Illinois Foundation, and the University of Illinois.

The FMC Educational Fund Fellowship was established in 1963 by a donation of 15,000 shares of stock in the Link-Belt Company (later acquired by the FMC Corporation, now FMC Technologies, Inc.) to the University of Illinois Foundation by Bert A. Gayman, an alumnus of the University of Illinois.

Eligibility:

- Full-time, first-year MBA student who will be enrolled full-time for two semesters during the second year (must not be receiving a tuition waiver, or any other financial assistance/support/scholarship from any other source during the second year);
- Minimum 3.5/4.0 grade point average after first semester of MBA study;
- Demonstrated leadership ability, involvement and commitment to Illinois MBA.

Required materials:

- Three letters of recommendation that addresses leadership abilities, commitment and involvement to the Illinois MBA.
- Essay (three pages maximum) indicating background, why applicant is deserving, career goals, and evidence of leadership and involvement.
- Resume
- Official academic transcripts from all higher education institutions (including UIUC)

Deadline:

- All materials must be submitted to Associate Dean of Illinois MBA no later than January 22.
- Awardees will be notified by the *Committee of Three* by May 1.
